The following pages will help you identify your snowplow attachment system:

UltraMount[®]/UltraMount[®] 2, UniMount[®], or Conventional.





UltraMount[®] 2

If you have an UltraMount[®] system plow, see pages 5–8 to identify your electrical system.

2 Jack stands on the outside (HTS™ snowplow only has 1 jack stand on the driver's side)

You drive into the plow with the receivers already on the truck.

UniMount®



If you have a UniMount system plow, you will need to use an UltraMount[®] to UniMount Adapter (PN 27170) along with an UltraMount vehicle mount. (UniMount mounts are no longer in production) See pages 5–8 to identify your electrical system

Lift cylinder is part of the hydraulic unit (Straight Blades Only)

1 Jack Stand in the center



Conventional



Conventional systems cannot be transferred to another vehicle.

Hydraulic unit and lights will stay attached to the vehicle when the plow is removed



ATTENTION:

- It is the responsibility of the installer to thoroughly review the condition of any electrical components being transferred.
- It is the responsibility of the installer to exercise extreme caution when routing harnesses during an electrical transfer.
- Western Products highly recommends replacing ALL vehicle-side electrical components when transferring electrical systems.


3- & 4-Port Isolation Module



If you have a 4-port module, you will have to convert to a 3-port system (Note 3- & 4-port modules require different lighting harnesses)



Some dealers may still have inventory of 4-ports & harnesses

The plug on the left has 11 pins and plug on the right has 4 pins (2 large pins & 2 small pins) If the plugs look like this please continue on page 9



Relay System

Left image shows 9 pins (straight blade); right shows 12 pins (V-plow). If you have one of these systems you will need to convert it to a 3-port isolation module system. See page 12 for straight blades and page 13 for V-plows.



3-Port, 3-Plug System

The top image is for a straight blade (center plug has 3 pins) the lower image is for a V-plow (center plug has 7 pins). See page 10 for straight blade and page 11 for V-plow.






Identify Which Electrical System Is on Your Plow

FLEET FLEX System

A FLEET FLEX system with an additional 3-pin plug that was added for the Chevy/GM Overvolt fix (Service Bulletin SP 840) for 2014 and later GM trucks only. If your plow has this electrical system and you are not transferring the plow to another 2014 or later GM, you can remove the 3-pin harness from the plow and see page 9 for our FLEET FLEX system for the common truck-side parts.








